The 1903 Courthouse Museum is open to visitors on Saturdays from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm, April through September. Group and bus tours are welcomed and must be scheduled in advance.

A guided tour through the Schoolhouse Room, Courtroom, Photography/Medical Room, Trail of Tears Room, George Lane Room, Homestead Room, Settler's Room, Military Room, , and the Vault Room is available- or you can explore at your leisure. The Gift Shop features Route 66 souvenirs, 1903 Courthouse T-shirts, historical publications, postcards, and souvenirs- including frog themed items.

Coming in 2015 will be an area to highlight the lost bridges of Pulaski County and celebrate the three historic Route 66 bridge crossings in our county.

The Pulaski County Courthouse was placed on the National Register of Historic Places on 17 July 1979.
